	Half Term 2	<p>Pupils will complete:</p> <p>AQA Spec 'A' GCSE Geography: Unit 'The Changing Economic World' – focus on the UK economy as well as developing countries.</p>	Full 3 paper mock examinations to cover all previous topics, including a fieldwork and Geographical Skills Paper.
Spring Term	Half Term 3	<p>Pupils will complete:</p> <p>AQA Spec 'A' GCSE Geography: 'The Living World' – with a focus on Cold Environments and Tropical Rainforests.</p>	Students will complete a series of 9 mark questions on case study knowledge from the Year 11 curriculum so far.
	Half Term 4	<p>Pupils will complete:</p> <p>AQA Spec 'A' GCSE Geography: ' The challenge of Resource Management' –</p>	Linear mock examination paper covering skills and content from Paper 1, 2 and 3.
Summer Term	Half Term 5	<p>Pupils will complete:</p> <p>REVISION for all 3 examination papers, with a focus on analysis of the pre-release examination material linked to Paper 3.</p>	Past paper questions will form the basis of ongoing assessment in class.
