

- Eduqas website also has helpful revision materials.






Expectations in English

Language: Edexcel

Literature: AQA

- Complete all H/W in independent learning book to highest standard & submit on time.
- English intervention **not automatic:** many reasons: only effective if **wants to be there**
- Intervention: Only useful if already trying to succeed by working hard in lessons
- **Read regularly**. More vocabulary you know, the better
- Language: Should be reading a novel/non-fiction text & weekly newspaper- ideally broadsheet
- Literature: Copy of texts: available electronically on our online library SORA
- A Christmas Carol: Romeo & Juliet: An Inspector Calls: Power and Conflict poetry collection
- Revision guides and workbooks for all these texts are **available** via the school website



- Ensure you have **pen, pencil, ruler and Casio scientific calculator** for **EVERY** lesson
- Complete **all H/W** as set by class teacher, to the **highest standard** & submit **on time**.
- Intervention: Invitation to those who already trying hard in class. You should work hard in every maths lesson, asking your teacher for help when needed.
- Make use of the recommended **online resources** Mathswatch, Corbett Maths, Maths Genie, Dr Frost, Onmaths ... Aim to do 15/20 minutes each night.
- **SPARX Maths** is a compulsory online homework tool for some classes. Failure to complete will result in SPARX club attendance afterschool.
- The best way to improve in Maths **IS TO DO MATHS. Past Papers** are an excellent revision resource and can be found online on a few sites (mathsgenie.co.uk)
- Revision guides are available via the school website



Expectations in Combined Science & Separate Science (Edexcel)



- Science is worth 2/3 GCSEs: Time spent on independent study reflects this
- Resilience is key: 'one' bad exam paper and bounce back
- Science revision must ensure that **both** knowledge retained & skills are practised
- Revision checklists/resources will be handed out before exams: copies also on TEAMs
- Many websites to support independent study; links placed on TEAMs
- Core Practical tasks must be revised: large focus on GCSE exam papers



Exam Board: AQA

- **HT2 Intervention**: (first 4 weeks): Focus on revision/exam technique in preparation for mock exams (attendance not compulsory at this stage)
- Selective intervention will begin from HT3
- **Independent Study** Students should be in a good home study routine. Wide range of resources available on Teams
- Subject Specific: Learn **geographical vocabulary** and use fluently within written work along with information from **case studies** to support answers in exams.

Revision guides and flash cards are available via the school website – if purchasing elsewhere, please ensure they are for the GCSE AQA specification (ask CSY if unsure)

Expectations in MFL

French & Spanish: AQA

- Access Languagenut regularly each week to complete both class teacher set tasks and independent study.
- Listening, Reading, Writing skills all equally contribute 25% to the total grade awarded. Therefore, all four skills require equal effort from pupils.
- Speaking questions must be prepared for all three themes, leant thoroughly and practised regularly to ensure success in the Speaking examinations. (Mock December 2023 / Final Speaking Examination April 2024)
- Intervention is only useful if already working hard in lessons and spending time revising independently at home.
- Learn your Vocabulary! The more vocab you know the better your chances of success in all four skills.
- **Revision Guides** are available via the school website.

Expectations in Art

- Working on **Portfolio** since start of Yr10. **60%** of grade.
- January: Begin **exam** question followed by a 10 hour unsupervised exam after Easter. **40%** of grade.
