Re: Update on Yr11 and Expectations/Plans

The Class of 2025, our great students in Yr11, are nearing the end of an era. To celebrate their last 5 years at St Damian's, there will be a Liturgy in school on **Friday 23rd May at 11.45-12.30pm**. This will be a reverent and respectful occasion. After this, parents will leave the school, and the students will have their final assembly to share memories and look back on their time here. This will be a light-hearted and joyous occasion, followed by the children staying in school during dinner time for the traditional 'shirt-signing'. The students will then leave school around 2pm.
