It is essential that we receive the Medical Form with emergency contact details for you. Unfortunately, no pupil will be allowed to travel without one.

Students will need to meet at school at 6am on Tuesday morning. The coach will depart at 6:30am prompt, please ensure your child has eaten or has provisions for breakfast on the day of travel.

Your child will not need spending money but if they do wish to bring money for the tuck shop no more than £20 is allowed.

Please encourage your child not to take anything valuable or sentimental as we want to avoid the risk of any damage or loss of any valuable property they may have.

Mobile Phones are allowed however they must not be brought to the sessions. Phones will be turned off and placed in a box with a member of staff at bedtime to be returned in the morning.

Castlerigg Retreat: 'Guidelines for a Happy Retreat'

The Castlerigg Team and St Damian's Staff ask you to observe the following guidelines. If they are followed in the right spirit, it will ensure you enjoy this retreat!

- 1. **Courtesy**: Please be on time for all meal times and sessions. Use the bins provided for rubbish. Chewing gum is not permitted anywhere on the premises. When you go to your rooms to prepare for bed you will have time to settle down. 'Lights Out' will be at your teachers' discretion. Always be respectful in the Chapel and during prayer times.
- 2. **Fire Procedures:** If you hear a fire alarm, leave the building as instructed; immediately and without fuss. Follow the green signs to the exits and line up at the fire assembly point. If the alarm goes at night, please wear warm clothes and put something on your feet before leaving the building. Make sure you switch off hairdryers, hair straightener's and any other electrical equipment when you leave your bedrooms.
- 3. **Smoking, Alcohol and Drugs:** Smoking is forbidden in any of the buildings. This rule has to be kept very strictly because of fire regulations and because it is now against the law to smoke in public places. If you smoke on the retreat, you will be sent home. For obvious reasons, it is forbidden to bring alcohol. If you are found to have drunk alcohol, taken drugs or found in the possession of either, you will be sent home.
- 4. **Bedrooms:** For reasons of space and privacy, there will be no mixed visiting, either day or night, and students must stay on their own corridors boys must not go into the girls' rooms and girls must not go into the boys' room. During the day, the rooms will be out of bounds without a member of staff present. Please respect any 'Private' signs as these rooms belong to staff at Castlerigg Manor.
- 5. **Damage:** Please report any damage done to the building or property immediately. This makes it easier to assess whether the damage was done before the group arrived.
- 6. **Leaving the Grounds:** You may not leave the grounds at anytime except for with a teacher you must not go into the wooded area or go out of the gates without a leader with you.
- 7. **Personal Property:** You are responsible for your own personal property, including money and mobile telephones. If you bring your mobile telephone make sure you switch it off during sessions and at meal
