Dear Parents / Carers,

Easter Revision [11th -22nd April 2022]

Year 11 revision sessions will take place during the Easter holidays for pupils identified as needing additional support to help them achieve well in their GCSE examinations. It is essential that pupils attend these sessions. A copy of the Easter revision timetable is available on the school website: <https://www.stdamians.co.uk/exams>

Exams are now imminent. MFL oral exams will take place w/c 9th May and written GCSE exams will start w/c 16th May. It is vitally important that pupils are working hard throughout the next six weeks to ensure they are ready for the exams.

If requested to attend school during the Easter holidays, pupils need to be aware of the following:

Safeguarding

- Parents are responsible for getting pupils safely to and from school
- If in exceptional circumstances, a pupil arrives late, they need to message the teacher on Teams so that they can be let in
- Pupils must go to the allocated room and stay under the supervision of their teacher
- Pupils are not allowed to go in other areas of the school

Registration

- Pupils must sign in at reception on a paper register provided by the teacher
- If a pupil is unable to attend a session, please let the teacher know in advance

Food & Drink

- Pupils will need to bring their own food & drink if staying all day
- Lunchtime will be 11.30-12pm in the dining room
- Pupils will be supervised by the teachers leading the morning intervention
- At 12pm, afternoon staff will collect pupils from the dining room and admit other pupils joining, through reception
- If pupils are attending an afternoon session on the same day as a morning session, they are not allowed off site at lunchtime

Break

- Pupils will be supervised in the classroom or in the dining room

Toilets

- At lunchtime, the toilets near Drama should be used

Behaviour

- Behaviour must be exemplary at all times
- Pupils are not expected to wear uniform but must dress appropriately
