HOME TEST KITS There are 3 lateral flow devices [LFD] in each box. Pupils will be issued with 3 boxes, so they have enough LFD's to test twice per week for the next 3 weeks [seeing them over Easter]. They will then

be issued with further boxes week beginning Monday 19th April when they return to school.

Pupil MUST test twice per week [report the results online to NHS Test & Trace and also by text message to <u>07507332277</u> school – please see further details below]

HOME KITS are to be used only by the person to whom they are assigned, they are NOT for use by family members.

Kits should be stored at room temperature (15-30 degrees centigrade)

school and during next week will be issued with 3 boxes of HOME TEST KITS.

PUPILS TESTING AT HOME

- Pupils [and parent/carer] must ensure you have duly read the instruction for use https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/instructions-for-covid-19-%20self-test [YOU MUST READ the separate booklet handed out and NOT the booklet in the boxes
- MUST watch the Gov.net video for how to perform home self-testing https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=S9XR8RZxKNo&list=PLvaBZskxS7tzQYIVg7lwH5uxAD9UrSzGJ
- 12-17 yr olds pupils can self-test at home and report results to NHS Test & Trace and school under supervision of an adult.
- Under 12yr old pupils should be tested by an adult who should also report their results to NHS Test & Trace and school.
- Leave at least 30 minutes after eating/drinking before taking the test.

COVID-19 Self-Test: Rapid Antigen Test Kit

I wanted to give you information on Home Test Kits and share with you the process. All pupils who

ALL self/home test results MUST be reported [negative or positive or void]. There are two steps:

- Report to NHS Test & Trace online www.gov.uk/report-covid19-result
- 2. Report to school TEXT <u>07507332277</u> the one-word result [negative or positive or void] so school can record the result[s] and any determine any relevant actions to be taken. You must use the mobile number you have registered at school for your child.

Please remember you are responsible for reporting incidents relating to the testing as follows;

- Report any clinical issue (e.g. bleeding, allergic reaction) https://coronavirusyellowcard.mhra.gov.uk
- Report any non-clinical issue via 119 (e.g. items missing from their kit)
- Inform school of any ongoing test related problems.
