This year instead of going out on a reward trip, because the 'Covid villain' is on the loose, the Carnival Rodeo is coming to St Damian's Ranch!

As well as our traditional trail up to Hartshead Pike, pupils will be able to have fun on

- The sheffiff inflatables
- Tame the rodeo bull
- Try their luck on the fairground games
- Create a wanted poster at the photo booth
- Complete their fancy dress costumes at the face painting booth
- Get creative at the Catctus arts and crafts station
- Pan for gold on the tombola
- Show off their dancing skills at the hoedown
- Caterwauling (singing badly!) on the karaoke

For the activities, we are asking for a voluntary donation of £10.00 per pupil via Sims pay. Any proceeds from the day will be donated to St Damian's chosen charity for 2021 – Macmillan Cancer Support.

At the St Damian's Saloon pupils can purchase and stock up on refreshments such as hotdogs, popcorn, candy floss, ice-cream, chocolate fountain and drinks. So, don't let them forget their pocket money!

Pupils are invited to wear fancy dress and be our cowboys, cowgirls, Sheriff or cactus on the St Damian's ranch! However, we ask parents to ensure that, in keeping with our Catholic ethos, no toy guns or weapons are used as props, pupils do not dress up using items that may cause offence to other traditional cultures and your child is dressed appropriately for this special event. St Damian's reserves the right to send any pupil home who does not adhere to this requirement.

For health and safety requirements on the day we ask that:

- All pupils wear sensible footwear suitable for the trail up to Hartshead Pike which will be fully supervised with staff marshalling as well as walking with the pupils. This will also be socially distanced.
- All pupils wear a hat/sunscreen if the weather is warm or warm clothes or waterproofs if the weather is poor
- All pupils have a drink for the trail to keep them hydrated (we will provide water stations along the route and first aiders)
- All pupils behave appropriately
