National Apprenticeships Week will take place 8th-14th February 2021. Please encourage your child to take part in as many activities as possible. All activities are accessible on Teams and on the school website / Careers Updates. Pupils in all year groups are invited to take part.

Three Key Questions to answer...

- What is an apprenticeship?
- Which job sectors offer apprenticeships?
- How do I apply?



Activities on offer:

1. Apprenticeships Competition – Y7-11

A Pupil Activity Pack will be put on each Year Group **Careers Team** on Monday 8th February 2021. The pack contains 10 different activities that pupils can select from. Pupils are asked to complete as many activities as possible and then to email their completed entry to <u>careerprospects@stdamians.co.uk</u>

There will be a prize for the best entry in each Year Group.

The best form participation in each Year Group with the highest number of entries will also be announced.

Other Events Online for Y9-11 [9th & 11th February 2021] - The Manchester College

Tuesday 9th February [11.00-11.30] - 'An introduction to T Levels'
